

Ordinance #17

BE IT ORDAINED, By the Council of the city of lake Norden, South Dakota:

That whenever any member of the Council of the City of Lake Norden whether elected or appointed to serve as a member of the said Council, who shall fail to attend to the regular meetings of the Council as provided by the Statutes, or any provisions hereafter enacted, for three consecutive meetings, unless he can show reasonable excuse, satisfactory to the Council for such absence, shall forthwith be declared ineligible and disqualified to vote at any meeting of the said Council, Provided; however, that at the first regular meeting of the Council following the absence for three consecutive meetings as above mentioned of the said member, two-thirds vote of those present at such meeting shall be necessary to declare sad member of the Council ineligible for further service on the said Council.

Immediately following a such action by the City Council in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, the said Council shall forthwith appoint a member to serve on the Council body for the unexpired term, but, no longer up to the next annual election, to fill the vacancy cause by such action.
