Overview of COVID-19

COVID-19 is a respiratory illness caused by a novel (new) virus, and we are learning more about it every day. There is currently no vaccine to protect against COVID-19. At this point, the best way to prevent infection is to avoid being exposed to the virus that causes it. Stopping transmission (spread) of the virus through everyday practices is the best way to keep people healthy.

Prevention is Key

Preventative measures for the spread of respiratory illness include:

- Frequent hand washing with soap and water for approximately 20 seconds
- Use of an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- Covering coughs or sneezes with a tissue
- Stay home when sick
- Stay hydrated (drink lots of water)

- Increasing hand sanitizer availability within our facilities as it is available
- Communicating prevention measures noted above to employees
- Encouraging employees to stay home if sick and showing symptoms of COVID-19
- Stopping unessential travel for city employees
