

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOR THE CITY OF LAKE NORDEN WASTEWATER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

The City of Lake Norden is proposing to construct improvements to its wastewater system. The City of Lake Norden is seeking up to \$3,700,000 for a new main lift station, replace approximately 1200 LF of gravity sewer piping and wastewater treatment facility improvements projects from the Board of Water and Natural Resources. The funds could be either grants from the State Consolidated Water Facilities Construction Program or a loan from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) program. The expected CWSRF loan terms are 2.5 percent for up to 30 years. The Board of Water and Natural Resources may forgive all or a portion of the loan principal. The amount and source of funds will be determined by the Board of Water and Natural Resources when the application is presented at a scheduled board meeting.

The project will be completed in two phases. Phase 1 will construct the new lift station at a cost of approximately \$700,000. Phase 2 will construct the gravity sewer line and improvements to the wastewater treatment facility at a cost of approximately \$3,000,000.

The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the proposed project, the proposed financing, the source of repayment for the loan and to receive comments regarding the application from members of the community. The meeting is open to the public and interested persons are encouraged to attend.
